## **Alternatives to in person voting.**

- If you are unable to vote in person, you can vote early by mail.
- If you are physically unable to mark your ballot, another person can do it for you under your supervision.

## **Reasons for voting early in person.**

- Your vote cannot be lost in the mail.
- There are no long lines.
- An unforeseen happening could prevent you from going on the official election day.

## **People who can help.**

- Volunteer drivers are available by contacting your political headquarters.
- A friend or onsite election official can mark your ballot for you under your supervision if you are physically unable to do it yourself.
- Election workers guarantee your right to fairness, privacy and a secret ballot.

## **Important issues.**

- Members of opposing political parties are not the enemy no matter how misguided you feel their opinions are. The best way to combat them and voice your opinion is to ***VOTE!***
